**Picnic run to Barren Grounds Nature Reserve,
Jamberoo Rd, ROBERTSON**

This picnic area is approximately 1 km off the Jamberoo Rd at the top of the Jamberoo Pass and does involve a dirt/gravel road for the last 1 km into the reserve. There is some shelter, and there are tables and a bush type toilet. Planned walks are mapped - the shortest to the escarpment lookout is about 1 hour. A total fire ban will no doubt apply. Be aware that there are no shopping facilities past the Robertson Pie Shop. However the Illawarra Fly (1300 362881) about 3 kms off the Jamberoo Rd has a café, and may suit some as an alternative particularly as the road is sealed.

- Leave the Pony Club via Osborne Rd travelling east.
- Turn RIGHT into Eridge Park Rd.
- Turn LEFT Moss Vale Rd, cross the Wingecarribee River and the Illawarra Railway Line to reach the Moss Vale roundabout.
- Turn LEFT at the Moss Vale roundabout and continue along the Illawarra Highway to Robertson.
- Continue through Robertson passing Fountaindale Manor (once Ranelagh House) on your RIGHT.
- Turn RIGHT at Jamberoo Rd at the Robertson Pie Shop corner following the signs to Barren Grounds, Illawarra Fly and Jamberoo.
- The turn off to the Illawarra fly is on the LEFT about 10 kms along this road.
- Take care particularly on the last section of this road towards Barren Grounds – the speed signs reflect some winding sections with tight corners.
- There is a Lookout (indicated by a camera sign) on the LEFT about 500metres before the Barren Grounds turn off.
- The turn off to Barren Grounds Nature Reserve is on the RIGHT just past a red warning sign on your LEFT. A brown tourist sign indicates 1km into the reserve and picnic area.
