Destination: Taralga Hotel, Orchard St, Taralga. Phone 4840 2007.

Distance 125 Kms approx.

- Leave Pony Club via Osborne Rd travelling east.
- Turn RIGHT into Eridge Park Rd.
- Turn LEFT into Moss Vale Rd.
- Continue through Moss Vale roundabout and the shopping centre then under the railway bridge remaining in Argyle St/Illawarra Highway.
- Enter the Hume Highway at Hoddles Cross Roads travelling towards Goulburn.
- Continue on the Hume Highway past Paddy's River and Marulan then take the first exit on the LEFT to Goulburn.
- You are now in Sydney Rd ( the Old Hume Highway) which passes down Governors Hill into Goulburn about 70 kms from Moss Vale.
- Cross Fitzroy Bridge over the Mulwaree River. The Correctional Centre is visible on your RIGHT.
- Turn RIGHT at the first traffic lights into Union St and follow into Wilmot St then Chantry St heading towards Taralga.
- Chantry St become Tarlo St (with the N.S.W. Police College on your LEFT) and then Taralga Rd.
- Cross the remains of the disused Crookwell Railway at Kenmore just before historic Kenmore Hospital on your RIGHT.
- Continue on Taralga Rd to Tarlo River (14 Kms), Chatsbury (7kms), Myrtleville (11kms) and finally Taralga (8kms).
- We expect to be at Taralga Pub at about 12 noon.
