Destination: Trainworks / Thirlmere Rail Heritage Centre

Leave the Pony Club via Osborne Rd heading east.

Turn LEFT into Eridge Park Rd.

Continue straight on at the roundabout where Eridge Park Rd becomes Old South Rd.

Remain on Old South Rd through the next three roundabouts.

Turn LEFT at the T intersection with the Old Hume Highway at Alpine.

Cross the Freeway towards Hilltop - you are now in Church Ave.

Turn RIGHT into Wilson Drive at Colo Vale heading towards Hilltop.

Much of this section is on old railway formation.

Cross the deepest rail cutting in the Southern Hemisphere, an interesting part of the rail heritage of this area.

Continue on this road until you reach Thirlmere.

The road becomes Barbour Rd. Trainworks/Thirlmere Rail Heritage Centre is on the right, with plenty of parking.

There is charge for entry.

For lunch we can:

Use the Museum on-site café – Quintessential Coffee Shoppe;

Use the local businesses;

Or picnic in the Museum Complex or the Park across the road.
